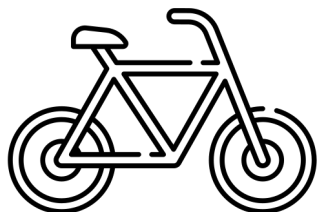
Financial Support

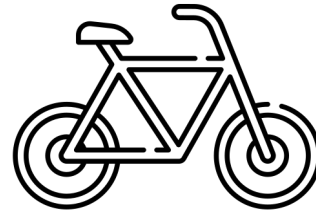
