Dear parent/carer

I am writing to inform you about the forthcoming mock examination series that all pupils in Year 10 will undertake which will involve a period of revision and support and will be a time where pupils will experience how an actual GCSE exam series is ran.

Pupils will have an assembly about exam conduct and expectations. The school follows the Joint Council for Qualification (JCQ) guidance, a copy is on the school website.

Exams will begin June 19th and conclude June 30th. All pupils must be in school during this time and ensure they are punctual for the start of every examination.

School uniform should be worn for this two-week period.

There are some pupils who will be eligible for access arrangements. This may include additional time and any alterations to the end of the school day will be communicated with those pupils and their parents.

Your child will get a personalised timetable, which will outline the order and times of the examination.

Pupils are expected to revise for every subject and their teachers will support them with specific areas that will be featured in their exams. We encourage a 'little and often' approach to revision.

Attached is a list of all the weekly interventions that we run. These are open to every pupil in Year 10. Pupils who have coursework components in their subjects have the best success when they complete the majority of work in Year 10 as this alleviates some of the pressure in Year 11. Please have a discussion with your child, about their coursework and what steps they are taking to ensure they complete as much work to the best of their ability now.

The mock examinations will give your child a realistic indicator of how well they are performing in each subject at this time and it will support their teachers to ensure they know what next steps are needed.
