Dear Year 10 Pupil,

I hope this letter finds you and your families safe and well.

Firstly, can I say a huge well done for all the learning and work you have submitted to your teachers over the last nine weeks. We have been amazed at some of your efforts and delighted to see the talents and creativity you have engaged with whilst you have been off. Please keep sending us your good work. The STAR certificates will continue to be shared each week in our bulletin.

I write to let you know that June learning will look different for you.

From June 1st there will be three parts to our approach:

1. New learning tasks will continue to be set each week on Doodle for you to access.
2. You will also be sent links via Doodle and your George Eliot Email to some pre-recorded lessons and quizzes. These will be videos of your teacher or other on-line videos and we ask that you watch and then answer what is needed.
3. Every week, there will be a number of 'live' sessions for the different subject areas. You need to make sure you familiarise yourself with these – they will offer you additional support and answer any of your questions so that you can complete number 1 and 2 with confidence.

You will be sent a schedule for the week and we ask that you make sure you access all the video lessons. Your teachers will be taking a register and checking that you are completing the work in this way.

There will also be form tutor 'live' sessions and your first one will be next week. This will offer you the chance to see your form and share anything you want or ask questions of your tutor.

During the week beginning June 22nd and June 29th, we will also see you being set some assessments to work through. You will have information on what to revise and a schedule to complete and hand in the work. This is incredibly important; it ensures that your learning from Year 9 until now is kept 'alive' it also helps us to help you focus on the areas you need to target for improvement. Further information about this will be sent out shortly.

We are doing this because we care. We need to make sure your wellbeing and your future is secure in the learning expected so you are ready for the academic challenges you will be faced with in your future. We understand there will be periods of difficulties or illness and your email/ phone check-ins and tutor check-ins should help to identify this and ensure we support you.

We ask that you:

- Try your best to stick to your schedule
- Ask questions to help your learning in the 'live' Q and A sessions or on email
- Keep yourself safe, staying active and making time for things you enjoy
