Dear Pupils and Parents

Further to our letter of the 13th March, as you may be aware, the Government has now amended advice and if one person in any household has a persistent cough or fever, everyone living there must stay at home for 14 days.

We remain open for business as usual for pupils who are not ill and are not self-isolating.

Our pupils remain our top priority, and therefore are sending this letter to you so that should you be in the situation whereby your child needs to remain at home and self-isolate they can still access school work and keep up to date with learning as best as possible.

If your child is self-isolating or is absent due to having symptoms of COVID-19 it is vital that they remain at home and you report this to us using the normal absence procedures.

For those who are self-isolating in line with government advice you are expected to work from home completing a range of the following each day:

- Using knowledge organisers for revision
- Hegarty maths
- Lesson work using booklets – copies of which can be found on the Academy website
- Homework set via Doodle by teachers
- You are also asked to maintain regular reading of fiction and non-fiction texts
- Revision for future exams and assessments
- Watching GCSE Pod clips
- Creating revision resources
- Homework from Educake


